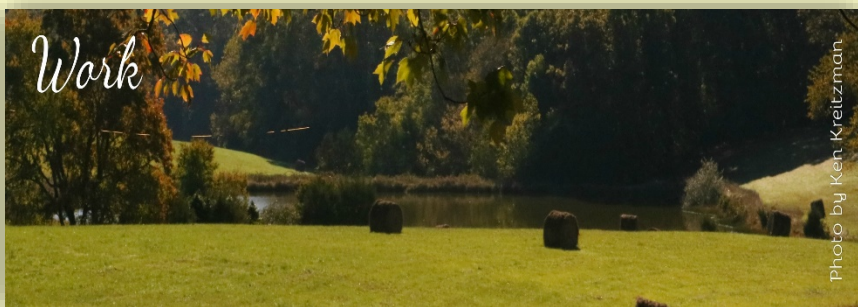




COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT
