A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE FY20 OPERATIONS BUDGET, SET THE TAX RATES AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors to approve and control the County's fiscal plan for FY20; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has received numerous staff reports; received comments from residents at a duly advertised public hearing on April 17, 2019; and has reviewed each request for funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors this 24th day of April 2019, that the Fluvanna County budget totaling **\$82,838,129** is adopted and the tax rates for FY20, the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, are set as given below:
