 - **Special thanks go to Bob Dorsey**, a community member and veteran, who donated to the project and gave of his time to speak to the student body about the importance of USO.

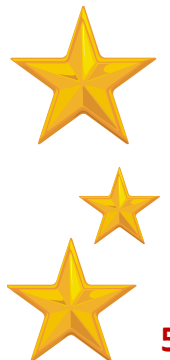

- **Adopted FY18 Fluvanna Arts Council Allocation = \$10,000**
 - \$5,000 County Contribution
 - \$5,000 Virginia Commission for the Arts Grant
- **County notified that Arts Grant funding to be cut to \$4,500**
