- Emergency Services Coordinator invited to observe the VOPEX14 exercise on Tuesday, July 8<sup>th</sup> at the Virginia EOC in Richmond
  - VOPEX14 is a full-scale exercise designed to establish a learning environment for players to exercise emergency response plans, policies, and procedures as they pertain to Nuclear Power Plant accidents.
- Fork Union Streetscape Update
  - Bids due August 1, 2014
  - Present contract to BOS September 17, 2014
  - Contract executed September 18, 2014 (Approx.)
  - Begin construction October 17, 2014 (Approx.)
  - Contract completion 150 days after construction begins



- Pleasant Grove House Construction
  - Substantial completion August 25, 2014
  - Final completion September 25, 2014
- Pleasant Grove Interpretive Plan Exhibits
  - Proposals due July 15, 2014
  - Present contract to BOS –August 6, 2014
  - Contract execution August 7, 2014
  - Final installation October 3, 2014 (Approx.)
- Pleasant Grove Amphitheatre
  - No date set; Waiting on final plans and scope of work from PW/P&R
