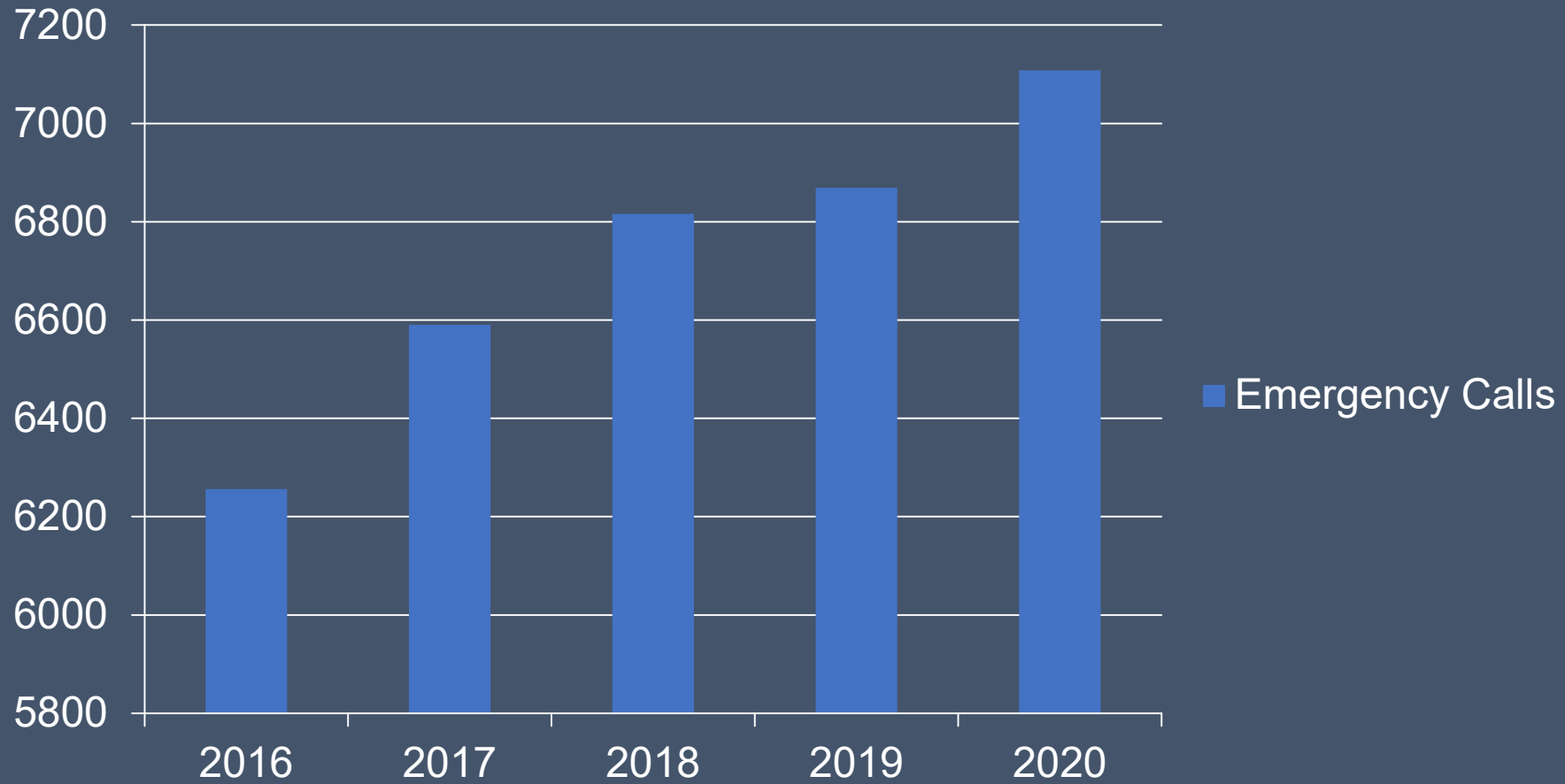

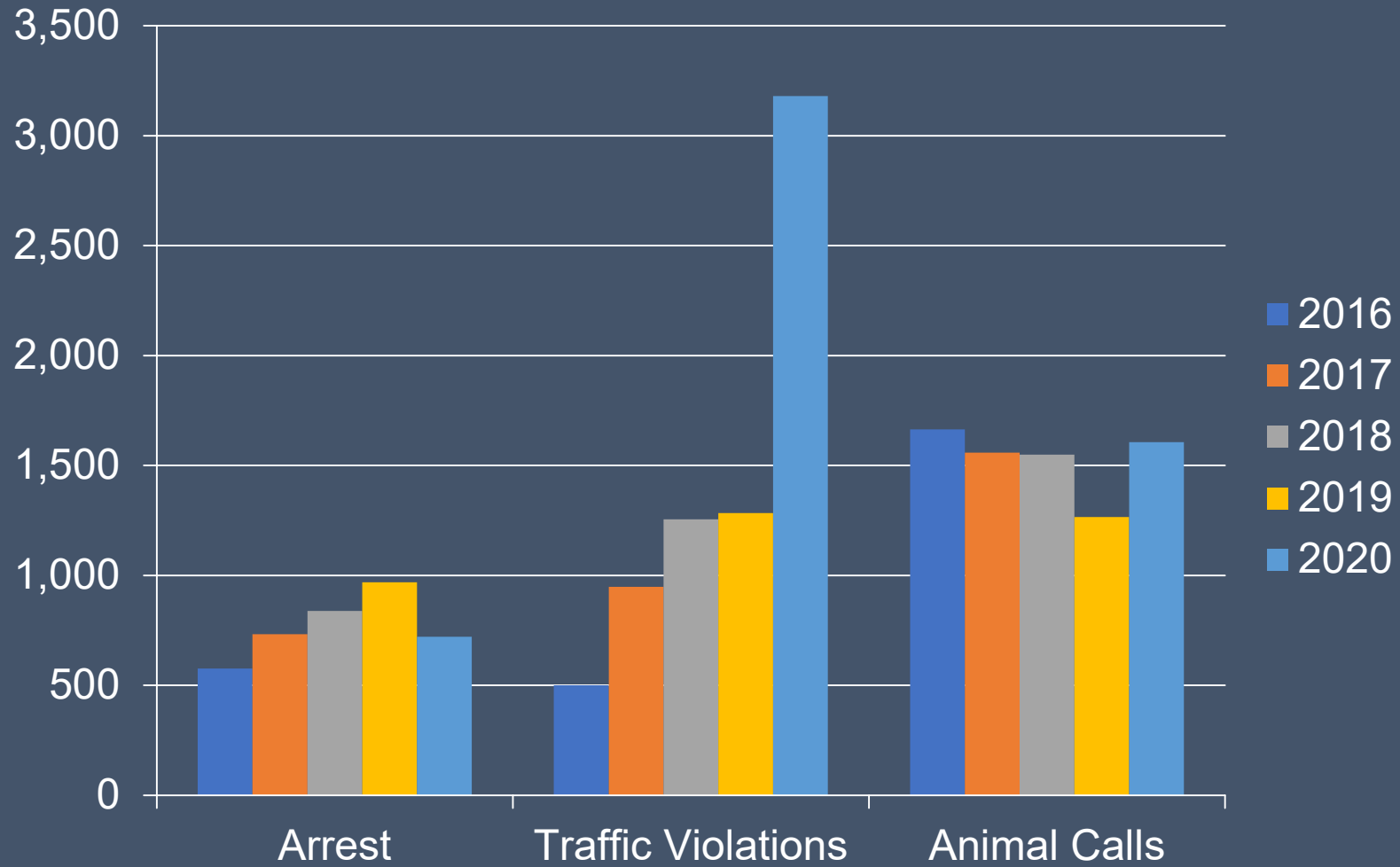

Less liabilities for all county stakeholders.

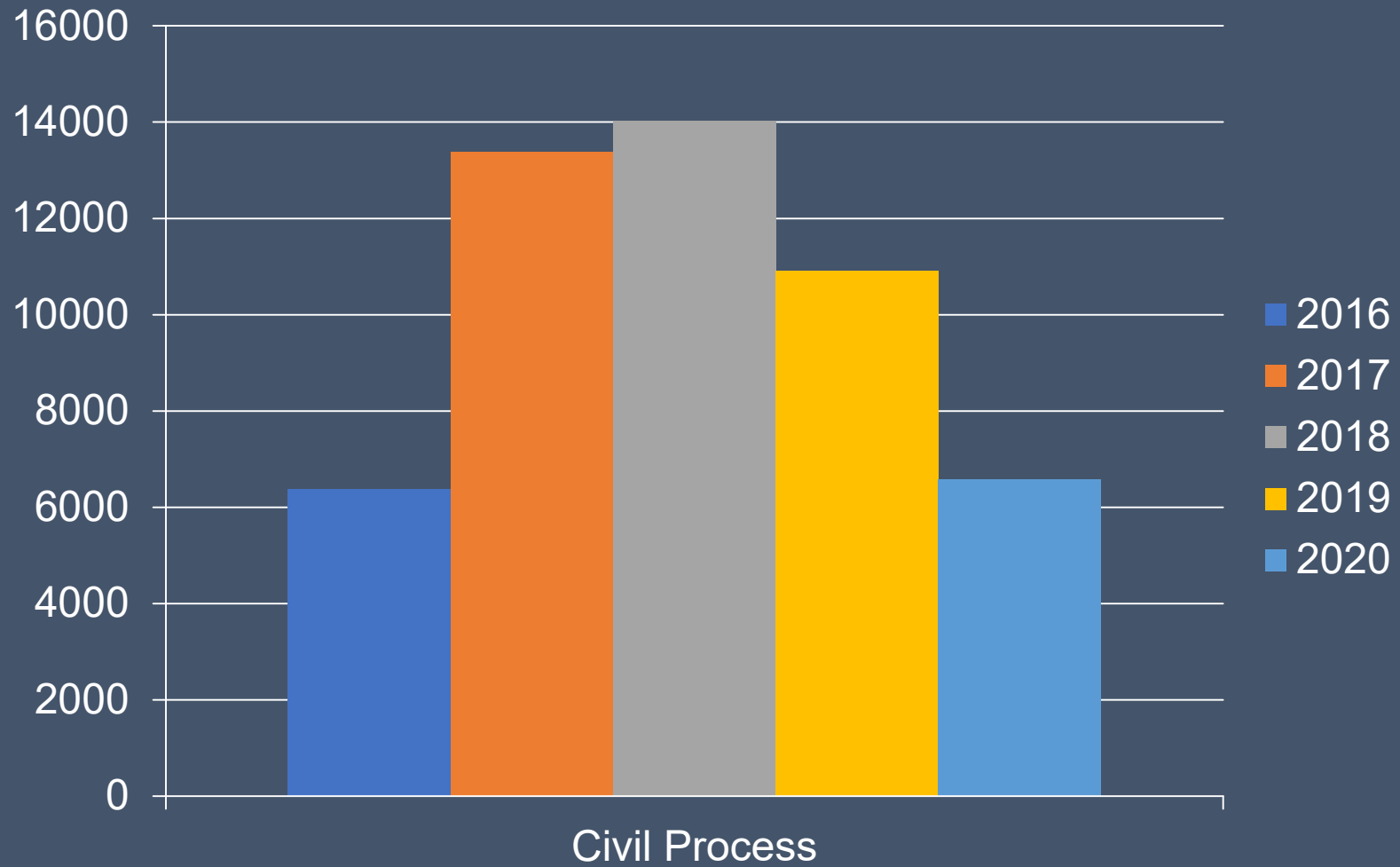


Judicial Case Load Increasing
