EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Emergencies and disasters can strike anyone, anytime and anywhere. They can happen quickly and without warning and can force you to evacuate your neighborhood or confine you to your home. Disasters and emergencies can create special challenges for seniors. You might not be quite as agile as you used to be; you might use a cane, walker or wheelchair; or you might have vision or hearing difficulties. Whatever your limitations, or even if you are in good health, you need to be prepared to handle an emergency. Local officials and relief workers will respond quickly after a disaster, but they cannot reach everyone right away. Knowing what to do until help arrives is your best protection. It is important to remember that local, state and federal government will do all it can to help disaster victims, but it cannot meet every need. Your emergency supply kit, emergency plan, and your family and friends are your most valuable resources in the immediate aftermath of a disaster.

You can get ready for emergencies with these three simple steps:
