

Well Water Testing: Drinking Water Clinic



Do you have a well, spring or cistern?

Learn about your water quality through affordable, confidential testing and become empowered to make decisions about system maintenance and water treatment! *The goal of the Virginia Household Water Quality Program is to improve the water quality and health of Virginians with private water supplies, including wells, springs and cisterns.*

How does it work?

- February 22-6:30 PM: Curbside pick-up.** Fluvanna Community Center- 5725 James Madison Hwy, Fork Union, VA 23055 Receive directions about sample collection and a pick-up sample kit. *Please contact office if you need other arrangements for kit pick-up.*
- February 24- Between 7:00 AM- 9:30 AM Collect samples and drop off at Fluvanna Community Center (Alternate sample drop off- Zions Crossroads Park and Ride. We will need to know at registration if using this site.)** Samples are sent to Virginia Tech for analysis.
- Results will be mailed.** If you need help interpreting your results, or information about addressing any problems or concerns, you may reach out to the VCE-Fluvanna Office. 434-591-1950.

What does the water test include?
