The goal of the Virginia Household Water Quality Program is to improve the water quality and health of Virginians with private water supplies, including wells, springs and cisterns.

How does it work?

- February 22-6:30 PM: Curbside pick-up. Fluvanna Community Center- 5725 James Madison Hwy, Fork Union, VA 23055 Receive directions about sample collection and a pick-up sample kit. Please contact office if you need other arrangements for kit pick-up.
- 2. February 24- Between 7:00 AM- 9:30 AM Collect samples and drop off at Fluvanna Community Center (Alternate sample drop off- Zions Crossroads Park and Ride. We will need to know at registration if using this site.) Samples are sent to Virginia Tech for analysis.
