- VDOE uses \$56,866,000 as total cost of new high school
- Fluvanna ranks 8th in State for cost of new high school per pupil

- LEED Certification Cost \$262,500
- Features:
 - 30% energy use reduction through high-performing HVAC, lighting, and envelope systems.
 - 43% water use reduction through low-flow plumbing fixtures.
 - Reflective roofing to reduce heat island effect, and permanent sun shading.
- This building achieved LEED-S Silver certification in March 2013
