## **CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Watson called the meeting of the James River Water Authority (JRWA) Board of Directors to order and Mr. Goodwin led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

## **FINANCIAL REPORT**

Mr. Dahl presented the financial report, detailing bills for consideration. He noted the significance of the bill from Faulconer Construction, stating that it was due to work on the pump station and well area of the project. Mr. Anderson asked about the bill for Three Oaks Engineering, and project team representatives responded that the amount covered required mussel relocation and that the firm is a subcontractor of Timmons Engineering.

## **PUBLIC INFORMATION AND DISCUSSION**

### **Discussion – Project Status Update**

Ms. Lauren Cambill (Faulconer Construction) reported on the progress of project efforts, which are primarily concentrated on the pump station area. She noted that the mud mat construction was proceeding as planned and that rebar work was underway. The access road has been topped with 21A stone and is holding up well to construction traffic. She stated installation of the power conduit was underway and should be completed by spring.

Mr. David Van Gelder reported that the remainder of the work at the Rivanna crossing should commence soon. General discussion of construction details ensued.
