# CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Duke called the meeting of the James River Water Authority (JRWA) Board of Directors to order at 10:30 a.m. Mr. Nichols led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

# **ADOPTION OF AGENDA**

On the motion of Mr. Dunning, seconded by Mr. Chesser, which carried by a vote of 4-0, the Board approved the agenda.

# **APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PRECEDING MEETING**

On the motion of Mr. Dunning, seconded by Mr. Nichols, which carried by a vote of 4-0, the Board approved the minutes of the May 2, 2017.

# **FINANCIAL REPORT**

Bills as presented in the packet and addendum were considered. On the motion of Mr. Nichols, seconded by Mr. Dunning, which passed by a vote of 4-0, the payments were approved.

# **DISCUSSION/INFORMATION ITEMS**

# **Discussion – Cultural Resources Work Update**

Mr. Nichols reported that Timmons Group has completed their cultural resources testing on June 2, 2017 and the drone flight for the view shed analysis is also complete. Discussion took place regarding the letters sent to the Army Corp of Engineers and Virginia Department of Historic Resources (VDHR) for

input on the burial permit request. No word has been received at this time, however, Mr. Goodwin is keeping in touch with officials from the Army Corp. of Engineers for any updates or comments.

# **ACTION ITEMS**

# Action Item - FY16 to FY17 Project Budget Carry-Over Request

Information was presented in the packet and the carry-over requests were considered. Questions and comments were addressed by the Board regarding the FY16-FY17 expenditures and future disbursements, which were answered by Mr. Nichols and Mr. Dahl. On the motion of Mr. Nichols, seconded by Mr. Chesser, which carried by a vote of 4-0, the Board voted to approve the carry-over request to the unexpected FY16 JRWA project budget in the amount of \$7,969,551.63 to the FY17 JRWA project budget.

# Action - FY18 JRWA Insurance Renewal

Mr. Dhal reviewed the insurance renewal information, which was presented in the packet. On the motion of Mr. Dunning, seconded by Mr. Nichols, which carried by a vote of 4-0, the Board voted to approve the FY18 JRWA insurance renewal, as amended.

# Action – FY18 Budget

Mr. Dahl briefly went over the FY18 budget information for the JRWA. Mr. Nichols noted a \$1,039 difference between expenses and revenues. Mr. Dahl stated the expenditures amount is correct and further discussion took place regarding the revenues. Mr. Nichols suggested that the service agreement amount from each locality be reduced by \$519.50. Mr. Dahl agreed. Mr. Nichols stated the amended service agreement from each locality should be in the amount of \$253,205.5. On the motion of the Mr. Dunning, seconded by Mr. Chesser, which carried by a vote of 4-0, the Board voted to adopt the FY18 JRWA budget, as amended, in the amount of \$506, 411.

# <u>Discussion – July Meeting Schedule</u>

Discussion ensued among the Board regarding the July meeting schedule. On the motion of Mr. Nichols, seconded by Mr. Dunning, which carried by a vote of 3-1, with Mr. Chesser voting against, the Board voted to move the July meeting from the 4<sup>th</sup> to the 11<sup>th</sup> same time and location.

#### **ADJOURNMENT**

On the motion of Mr. Nichols, seconded by Mr. Dunning, which carried by a vote of 4-0, the Board voted to adjourn the meeting at 10:57 a.m.

This Compensation Agreement (the "Agreement") dated ZI HPZIL, 20 17, is entered into by Central Virginia Electric Cooperative, a Virginia cooperative(the "Property Owner"), sole owner of the fee simple title to property which is the subject of a Deed of Easement, (the "Conveyance Instrument"), between Property Owner and the James River Water Authority, a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, (the "Authority") to be recorded in the Fluvanna County Circuit Court Clerk's Office, a copy (copies) of which is (are) attached to and incorporated into this Agreement.

Property Owner and Authority agree as follows:

CENTRAL VIRCINIA ELECTRIC COORERATIVE

- 1. That payment in the amount of \$2,300.00 is fair and just compensation for conveyance of the rights described in the Conveyance Instrument. Compensation shall be paid upon recordation of the Conveyance Instrument in the Clerk's Office. Recording is contingent upon Authority obtaining releases and other documents as necessary to insure that clear title to the rights under the Deed of Easement satisfactory to Authority, is conveyed. Property Owner agrees to cooperate in obtaining necessary release(s) from lien holders; however, all processing fees for said release(s) shall be paid for by the Authority.
- Upon acceptance by the Authority, Property Owner will be provided a fully executed copy of this Agreement within a reasonable amount of time, but no later than delivery of compensation. If not accepted, Property Owner will be notified in writing.
- 3. The terms of this Agreement shall extend to and be binding upon the parties upon completion of construction or one (1) year from the date set forth above, whichever is sooner.

THIS DEED OF EASEMENT is entered into 21 April 2017, 2016, by CENTRAL VIRGINIA ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, a Virginia cooperative, GRANTOR(S), and the JAMES RIVER WATER AUTHORITY, a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, GRANTEE.

#### WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the sum of \$10.00 paid by the Grantee to the Grantor(s), receipt of which is acknowledged, the Grantor(s) conveys to the Grantee the following described easement, to whit:

A perpetual easement, designated "20' WATER AND ACCESS EASEMENT (3,905 S.F.)" on a plat by Timmons Group dated 6/26/2016, titled "PLAT SHOWING A 20' WATER AND ACCESS EASEMENT AND A VARIABLE WIDTH TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENTS ACROSS THE PROPERTY OF CENTRAL VIRGINIA ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE" ("the Plat"), a copy of which is attached to, incorporated in, and recorded with this deed. Reference is made to the Plat for a more complete description of the real estate, with right to erect, construct, install and lay and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace, and remove utility lines for the purposes of provision and conveyance of water and sewer and appurtenances thereto, including, but not limited to, manholes, valves and related equipment on the land of the Grantor(s) as shown on the Plat; however, such easement does not grant the right to erect any structures on the easement herein granted.

The Grantor(s) further grants and conveys to Grantee and its agents full and free use of the said easements and rights for the purposes named and all rights and privileges reasonably necessary to the enjoyment and exercise of the easements, including the right of reasonable access to and from the easements and the right to

use adjoining land where necessary; provided, however, that this right to use adjoining land shall be exercised only during periods of actual surveying, construction, reconstruction, or maintenance; and further, this right shall not be construed to allow the Grantee to erect any building or structure of a permanent nature on such adjoining land.

Together with a 25,788 square foot temporary construction easement, designated as "VARIABLE WIDTH TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT" on the Plat (the "Easements"). The Easements shall be used to construct, operate, maintain, inspect and repair a drainage system and related improvements including slope(s), together with the right of ingress and egress thereto from a public road. Reference is made to the Plat for a more complete description of the Easements.

The Grantee shall have the right to trim, cut, and remove trees, shrubbery, fences, or other obstructions or facilities in or near the easement(s) being conveyed deemed by it to interfere with the proper construction, operation, and maintenance of its utility facilities within the easement; provided, however, that the Grantee at its own expense shall restore, as nearly as possible, the premises to their original condition, such restoration to include, as a minimum, backfilling of trenches, replacement of shrubbery, resodding, and reseeding of lawns and pasture areas, but not the replacement of structures, trees, or other obstructions, with the exception of mailboxes, which may be reasonably relocated as part of the replacement.

Being a portion of the same property conveyed to CENTRAL VIRGINIA ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, a Virginia Cooperative, by deed from Raja F. Abouzaki and Najwa A. Abouzaki, husband and wife, dated August 19, 1996 and recorded November 7, 1996 in Deed Book 308, page 224 in the Circuit Court Clerk's Office of Fluvanna County, Virginia.

The Grantor(s), by the execution of this instrument, acknowledges that the plans for the project as they affect the subject property have been fully explained to the Grantor(s) or its authorized representative.

The Grantor(s) covenants that it has the right to convey the land to the Grantee, that it has done no act to encumber the same and that it will execute such further assurance of the same as may be necessary.

The Grantor(s)covenants and agrees for itself, its heirs, successors, and assigns, that the consideration stated above is in lieu of any and all claims to compensation for land, and for damages, if any, to the remaining lands of the Grantor(s) that might result by reason of the use to

which the Grantee will put the land to be conveyed.

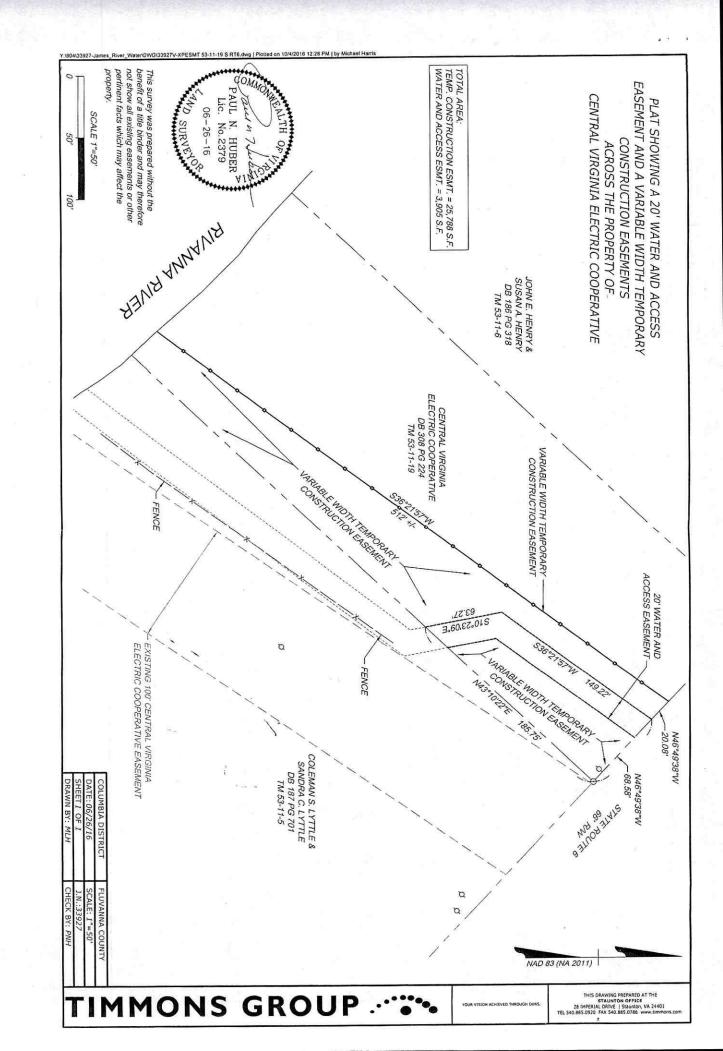

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

We have reviewed Faulconer Construction Company's APPLICATION AND CERTIFICATE FOR PAYMENT #4 (Pay App #4) as attached for the James River Water Project PPEA. Pay App #4 appears to be a fair and accurate accounting of cost reimbursement due in accordance with conditions of the contract.
