#### CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Watson called the meeting of the James River Water Authority (JRWA) Board of Directors to order at 9:00 a.m. and led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### ADOPTION OF AGENDA

On the motion of Mr. Anderson, seconded by Mr. Goodwin, which carried by a vote of 4-0, the agenda was adopted with the addition of an Action Item for consideration of solicitation and proposals for phase three treatment plan efforts.

#### **ITEMS FROM THE PUBLIC**

(none)

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PRECEDING MEETING

On the motion of Mr. Dahl, seconded by Mr. Anderson, which carried by a vote of 4-0, the Board approved the draft minutes from the preceding meeting.

#### **FINANCIAL REPORT**

Mr. Dahl briefed the Board on bills in the packet for consideration. On the motion of Mr. Goodwin, seconded by Mr. Anderson, the bills were approved by a vote of 4-0.

#### PUBLIC INFORMATION AND DISCUSSION

#### **Discussion – Project Status Update**

Mr. Justin Curtis of Aqualaw provided an update on the project status. Work by the project team on the phase three treatment plan is wrapping up for the Corps of Engineers permit application, and Goodwin and Associates is currently working on that. For the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) permit, the application has gone through DEQ's internal review and has been circulated for review by other agencies. Some minor clarifications and details were requested, which the project team provided. DEQ is finalizing the technical review and modeling, which is expected to be completed quickly. DEQ will then issue a draft permit for our review, after which it will be published for a 30-day comment period before final approval and issuance. Regarding the Virginia Marine Resources Commission permit, the Virginia General Assembly passed House Bill 2181 and is now awaiting signature by the governor. This legislation eliminates duplicative permitting efforts and would negate the need for this permit since the JRWA is already pursuing a DEQ permit that involves stream crossings.

Mr. Goodwin asked if the Department of Historic Resources had been briefed on the JRWA's intent to submit multiple phases of the application at once, as had been discussed at prior meetings. Mr. Curtis replied that they had and were amenable to the same.

#### ACTION ITEMS

Mr. Hefty reported that Goodwin and Associates has drafted the phase three treatment plan, which will be submitted for agency review. When it is approved, the JRWA will need to solicit proposals in accordance with the Virginia Public Procurement Act to complete the phase three work. Goodwin and Associates is qualified to complete the work and the JRWA would benefit from allowing them to propose even though they developed the treatment plan. State code prohibits this, unless it would restrict viable proposals and inhibit efforts at effective procurement.

On a motion by Mr. Goodwin, seconded by Mr. Anderson, which passed by a vote of 4-0, the JRWA approved permitting R. Christopher Goodwin & Associates to submit a proposal for the Phase III Treatment Plan Services or any portion thereof because the exclusion of Goodwin & Associates would limit the number of potential qualified offerors in a manner contrary to the best interests of the James River Water Authority.
