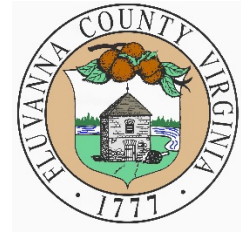

SURVEY ACCESS AND ARTIFACT DONATION AGREEMENT:

This Survey Access and Artifact Donation Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between the James River Water Authority (“JRWA”), a joint authority formed by Fluvanna County and Louisa County, and the individual named below (“Owner”).

I. Background

JRWA proposes to construct the James River Water Supply Project to withdraw water from the James River to provide a reliable, long-term public water supply for the residents of Fluvanna and Louisa Counties. JRWA plans to conduct an archeological survey on Owner’s property to determine whether any sites are present. That information may help inform a future decision by JRWA about where to locate a buried 24-inch water pipe.

It is possible the archeological survey may uncover artifacts which will provide valuable information about the historical or prehistoric use and occupation of the property. Any artifacts found are the property of the Owner. However, the preferred disposition of artifacts is to allow them to be donated to a state agency, museum, or similar entity that can permanently preserve and curate the artifacts for research and educational purposes.

II. Access the Owner’s Property to Conduct Survey

A. JRWA will ensure that the archeological field study and artifact collection will be conducted by or under the supervision of a qualified archeologist and in accordance with all applicable federal and state authorities, permits, and agreements.

B. The archeological survey involves a team of three to five surveyors with shovels digging approximately 20-inch wide holes to a typical depth of no more three feet. The top layer of grass is removed intact so it can be replaced with minimal disturbance. The holes are dug at roughly 50-foot intervals along the survey corridor. If evidence of archeological sites is found, additional holes may be dug nearby. Once a hole is complete, it is filled in and the grass is replaced.

C. The survey team typically will complete its work on a property within a single day. The Owner will be provided advance notice of the expected date(s) and if the work is expected to take more than one day.

D. If requested, JRWA will provide a copy of public reports and information relating to the archeological study of Owner's property.

III. Handling and Disposition of Historical Artifacts

A. Artifacts uncovered during the archeological study on Owner's property will be handled and managed in accordance with guidelines published by the Virginia Department of Historical Resources ("VDHR").

B. Artifacts found on Owner's property will be removed for the purposes of examination, testing, study, preservation, and/or temporary storage.

C. Upon completion of the archeological study, JRWA intends to donate the artifacts to the VDHR or to such other qualified collection facility or museum as may be designated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and VDHR for the permanent preservation and curation of the artifacts. If donated, the VDHR or such other designated recipient of the artifacts shall have title free and clear to process and preserve the collection and to use the donation for research and education on an unrestricted basis.

D. Owner and JRWA agree to execute further documents as may be necessary to facilitate the donation of the artifacts to the VDHR or such other designated recipient.
