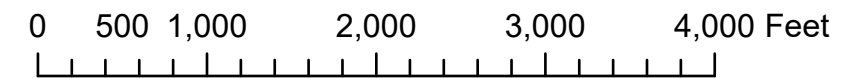
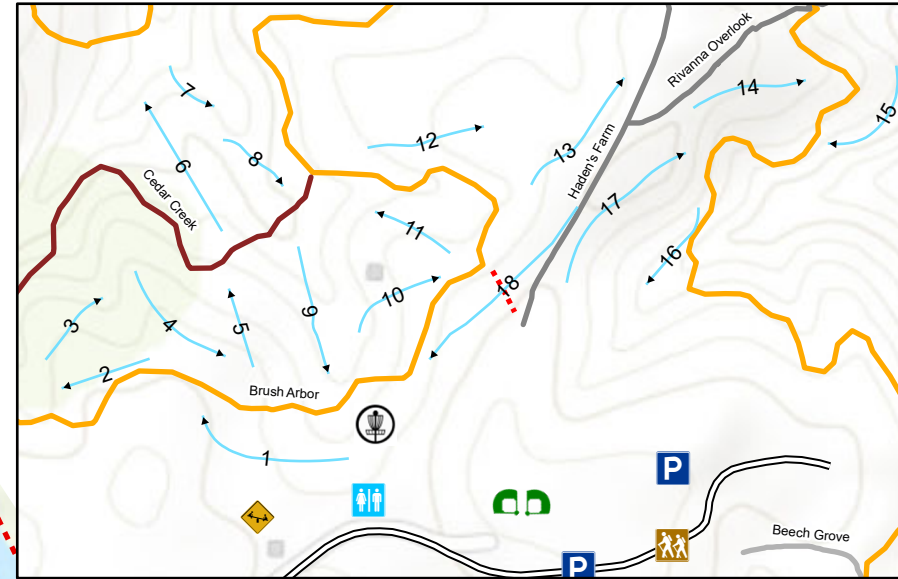

PARK RULES

- Park and Trails Open During Daylight Hours
- No Open Fires
- No Camping/Overnight Stays
- Horses Remain on Designated Equestrian Trails
- Hunting is Prohibited
- Fishing Permitted with Proper License
- No Vehicles Allowed on Trails or Open Spaces
- Dogs Must Remain on a Leash at all Times, Except in Designated Off Leash Areas. (DOLA)

STAY ON TRAILS

Staying on trails is a simple way to protect the park and trails. Shortcutting trails causes erosion and damages trailside plants. Walk and ride on designated trails, but not when muddy. If you MUST leave a trail, protect vegetation by stepping on rocks, gravel or other non-vegetated surfaces. Avoid Hiking and riding on areas that are closed for re-vegetation or signed as sensitive.
