Schedule of Erosion Control Fees: \$250 initial plan review fee \$100 per re-review fee \$550 plus \$125/arce. or portion the of over one acre for work to be completed within twelve months. \$500 plus \$50/acre or portion over one acre for additional twelve months (twentyfour months total) \$500.00 for each additional twelve months (over twentyfour months total) Permit payment is due apon issuance of Land Disturbing Permit. Permits are required to be renewed every twelve months untill released by this office. Failure to renew this permit by the expiration date will result in the automatic revocation of the Land Disturbing Permit. If your permit is revoked; a stop work order will be issued and you will then be required to obtain a new permit at the original cost. Failure to reapply for a new permit within thirty days of expiration date will result in further action under the Virginia Erosion
