



Most voters in Fluvanna County will be voting using a paper ballot that is fed into an optical scanner.

Once you have Checked-In at the Pollbook Station please take your Voter Pass to the Ballot Station to receive your ballot and then to a Ballot Marking Booth where a pen will be provided for you to mark your ballot. **(REMEMBER to leave the pen in the voting station.)**

Marking Your Ballot:

- **Follow the instructions at the top of your ballot.**
- **Fill in the oval to the right of the candidate's name of your choice.**
- **If you are writing-in a candidate's name please be sure to fill in the oval to the right of their name.**

Once you have marked your ballot take it to the OVO (OpenElect Voting Optical) Scanner and insert it. (You may feed the ballot upside down to insure your privacy.) Wait until the scanner light turns from **green** to **red** back to **green** and the OVO screen thanks you for casting your ballot.

In the event there is an emergency while voting an Officer of Elections will assist you with placing your ballot into the Emergency ballot box attached to the OVO Scanner.

EVIDENCE RESTRICTING THE SALE OF BREWED COFFEE TO ORGANIC, FAIRTRADE, OR SHADE-GROWN CERTIFIED COFFEE

The People of the City of Springfield do ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, coffee growers often use synthetic chemical pesticides and fertilizers; and

WHEREAS, coffee growers often cut down trees; and

WHEREAS, the growing of coffee in the manner described above produces an adverse effect upon the environment which is injurious to the health, safety, comfort, convenience, welfare and happiness of the residents of the City of Springfield; and

WHEREAS, the sale of the hereinafter enumerated beverages would reduce the adverse effect mentioned above and benefit the citizens of Springfield and others outside the City of Springfield; and

WHEREAS, the sale of the hereinafter enumerated beverages would encourage others to sell the same; and

WHEREAS, the passage of a City of Springfield ordinance restricting the sale of brewed coffee to the hereinafter enumerated beverages would encourage others to do the same; and

WHEREAS, the regulation of the sale of brewed coffee within the City of Springfield is a municipal affair and in the public interest.

The City Manager or the Manager's designated representative is authorized to enter the business premises of any business vendor engaged in the sale of brewed coffee beverages in the City and which business vendor is licensed by the City to conduct a business, for the sole purpose of inspecting said premises and determining whether the business vendor is in compliance with this ordinance.
