POLLS ARE OPEN FROM 6 A.M. TO 7 P.M. FOR ALL ELECTIONS

Check your voter registration card or letter for your correct voting site.
All voters are required to present photo identification at the polls.

Contact your General Registrar for appropriate forms of identification,
or visit the VA Department of Elections website.

You are eligible to register to vote if you are:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Virginia
- At least 18 years of age or will be by the next general election

VOTER REGISTRATION

Where You may apply online or at the following sites: County Registrar Office, Public Library; Department of Motor Vehicles Offices; Public Assistance Agency offices, i.e., those offering food stamps, aid to dependent children and/or aid to persons with disabilities, etc.; Military Recruitment Offices, or District Governmental Centers. For other locations and for more information contact your General Registrar.

When You may register year round except during the 21 days prior to a general or primary election or 13 days prior to a special general election. Registration will be permanent under most circumstances.

If To remain a qualified voter, you must notify your local voter registration office of any change in your name or address.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Any registered voter who expects to be away or otherwise physically unable to go to the polls on Election Day, may request an absentee ballot.

By Mail or Fax: Application forms may be requested from the General Registrar's Office beginning ten months before the general election and are also available at registration sites and governmental centers. Mailed applications must be received by the General Registrar not less than seven days before an election. Voted ballots must be received in the office by 7 p.m. Election Day to be counted.

In Person: Registered voters may apply for and vote an absentee ballot in person at the Registrar's Office beginning 45 days before an election. In-person absentee votes must be cast by 5 p.m. on the Saturday before each Election Day.

While the districts for the Virginia General Assembly were changed in the 2021 redistricting, Fluvanna's representatives in the Virginia House and Virginia Senate will remain until January of 2024 (after the Fall elections of 2023), when all of those current members' terms expire. Fluvanna is currently served in the Virginia Senate by both the 22nd and 25th districts. Under redistricting, all of Fluvanna County will fall within the new Virginia Senate district 10.

Fluvanna County is currently served by the 58th and 65th Virginia House of Delegates districts. Those members' terms also expire in January of 2024. Fluvanna voters will choose a member of the Virginia House of Delegates in the new district 56 in the November 2023 election. A small number of Fluvanna voters in Scottsville are in the 55th House District.

Fluvanna will continue to have full representation in regular and special sessions of the General Assembly by the current State Senators and Delegates until the new members are elected.

Virginia voters may now take advantage of same-day registration and voting, both in the 21 days prior to an election and on Election Day itself. These ballots will be considered provisional until registration is approved
